

S2 Fig. Immunohistochemical staining of C-C motif chemokine receptor 6 (CCR6) expression in rectal cancer tissues. (A) Specimen with low CCR6 expression (\times 100). (B) Specimen with low CCR6 expression (\times 400). (C) Specimen with high CCR6 expression (\times 100). (D) Specimen with high CCR6 expression (\times 400). Panels B and D showed the higher magnification from the area of the boxes in panels A and C, respectively. In the high CCR6 specimens, the expression level was elevated both in the tumor cells and the adjacent tissue. But the elevation of expression level was more obvious in the tumor cells.
