



**Supplementary Fig. S1.** Tendency of epidermal growth factor receptor (*EGFR*) mutation-positive rates according to age. Exon19del was more common than L858R in younger patients, but L858R was slightly more frequent than Exon19del in older patients. Summing the frequencies resulted in the peak incidence of *EGFR* mutation located at the ages between 50 and 60.
