(B) Abdominal CT 24 months later, showing innumerable and scattered low-attenuation lesions in the liver parenchyma, spleen, and both kidneys, and multiple small lymph nodes at the lower paraesophageal, perigastric, portocaval, retrocaval, paraaortic, retroperitoneal, liver hilum, hepatoduodenal ligament, common hepatic artery, and celiac axis areas.
