

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**Supplementary Fig. 1.** Receiver operating characteristic (ROC) curve with area under the curve (AUC) for stomach width/length (W/L) ratio after 32 weeks and 36 weeks of gestational age (GA) for the suspicion of esophageal atresia (EA) (exclusion of 6 EA cases without polyhydramnios). After 32 weeks: Cut-off value <1.375, AUC=0.693 (95% confidence interval [CI], 0.526–0.861; *P*=0.032). Sensitivity 0.846, specificity 0.500, positive likelihood ratio (LR<sup>+</sup>) 1.692, negative likelihood ratio (LR<sup>-</sup> 0.308). After 36 weeks: Cut-off value <1.465, AUC=0.684 (95% CI, 0.461–0.906; *P*=0.091). Sensitivity 0.761, specificity 0.625, LR<sup>+</sup> 2.029, LR<sup>-</sup> 0.382.
