(B, C) Several diverticula were found in the lesions. We attempted to resect the diverticulum using strategy B. However, in one of the diverticula (yellow arrow), the dissection space between the lesion and the diverticulum was insufficient. (D, E) Since the remaining mucosal area was confirmed to be non-neoplastic, a mucosal incision was made in the visible region. (F) R0 resection was performed in this case.
